### **Community feedback sought for Victoria Park Lake family precinct and playground**

Greater Shepparton City Council is asking residents for their feedback on play equipment for a new family precinct at the northern end of Victoria Park Lake.

The feedback from residents will be used to help select the main play equipment at the Family Precinct for the entire community to use. Council is allocating approximately \$350k for the new family play area that will include new playground equipment suitable for toddlers, primary school aged children and teenagers. The playground will include a flying fox, swings and other exciting play structures and areas of shade.

Along with the new toilets the family precinct will be located to ensure this potential utilisation of the area is improved at the Northern end of Victoria Park Lake.
